Agenda items voted on at September Meeting

- (1) Raise the cost of State shoots from \$20.00 to \$30.00. Additional members \$10.00 with a max of \$60.00 for VBA members. Non VBA members would be \$40.00 with no breakdown for family. Roll Call Vote, 14 yes, 5 no, Passed, effective date 01/01/2022
- (2) Page 26 B. Definitions: Add Barebow Recurve to the shooting style section on line 2a. Roll Call vote, 11 yes, 6 no, 2 abstained. Passed, effective 01/01/2022.

Agenda Item to be voted on at January meeting

- (1) Separate Duties to be Volunteers Thus Removing the \$5 Cost of Each VBA Member. Constitution Section 4.5, VBA Bylaws Article 8: Dis-establish the Executive Secretary/Treasurer and establish a separate Secretary and Treasurer with the said responsibilities below as elected volunteers. They shall be elected positions filled by volunteers, the same as the other officers. This shall be enacted upon retirement, resignation, by reason of death disqualification, or by otherwise, by majority vote of a quorum of the board of directors. Justification: With Membership down to under 1000 head of households and the financial shape of the organization is in it does not warrant a paid officer to receive for services a salary of \$5.00 per member.

Corresponding Secretary: It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary

The State Indoor Shoot was hosted by several clubs and due to COVID restrictions, the awards were mailed to the winners. This worked well, but it took a lot of coordination by all the clubs. The other four shoots went forward as usual. The shoot attendance was down a bit this year. The number of shooters for all shoots was 253. However, we had an outstanding number of state records broken this year. A total of 31 records were broken and I believe that is a record in itself! VBA has a number of great archers.

We held our scheduling session on September 19th. We had 81 shoots put on the calendar. The motion to raise the shoot fees was passed by the delegates attending the meeting. The fees have been the same since 1988 and it was time for a change that would benefit both the clubs hosting the shoots and VBA.

Looking forward to a less restrictive 2022 season. Remember to come out and support the clubs as it cost a lot of money to host these shoots

to accept dues, maintain, and submit membership records for the organization. The Corresponding Secretary shall file all required insurance, tax, lease and Regulatory reports; act as custodian of the VBA corporate seal, affixing an impression here of to any papers requiring the same; process non-financial vouching documents for receipts include but not limited to, membership applications, tournaments, reports and membership renewals. It shall also be his/her duty to receive and submit all necessary correspondence to the charter clubs, membership and/or other organizations that the organization may be affiliated with.

Treasurer: It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to take charge of the funds of the organization subject to the general supervision of the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall, under the direction of the Board of Directors, give negotiate, or endorse such checks, notes, and bills as may be required in conduct of business of the organization. He/she have authority to collect the funds of the organization, and he/she shall deposit all funds so received, in such bank/banks as the board of directors may from time to time designate. The Treasurer shall keep proper books of accounting which shall always be subject to examination by the President or the Board of Directors or any agent. The Treasure shall render at all regular scheduled club meetings a statement showing the financial condition of the organization. At the last regular meeting of the membership, the Treasurer shall submit a written statement showing the financial condition of the organization and a detailed report of the receipts, disbursements, and expenses for the calendar year. The Treasurer shall be responsible for such duties as may be required by the Board of Directors.

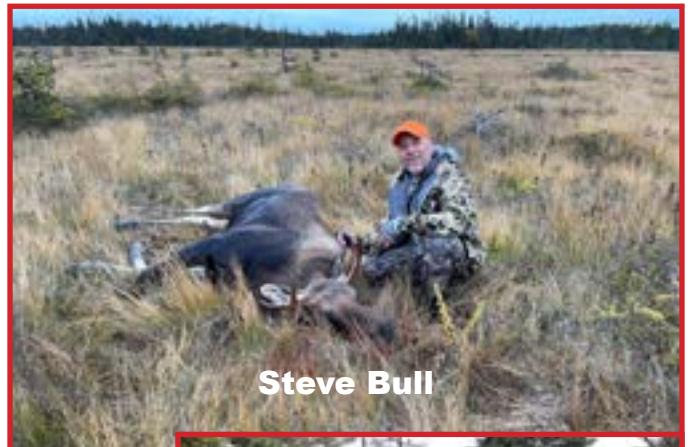

The Order of the Golden Feather is extremely sad to notify you that Richard M. "Rick" Atchison, passed away on August 4, 2021. A member of the Belvoir Bowhunters, he was elected in 2018 to the VBA's highest honor, the Order of the Golden Feather. His contributions to the VBA at club, region, and state levels were truly outstanding and he is one of only 87 members elected to the Order since the VBAs inception in 1941. Rick was a retired Air Force colonel who brought his management skills and initiative to archery. His extremely positive interaction with Wounded Warriors via archery and his active participation in many groups and studies that impact wildlife conservation at local, state and national levels leave a void that will be hard to fill. He will be sincerely missed by the many friends whose lives he touched – especially those with whom he shared quiet moments in the woods. The VBA and the OGF extend condolences to the Atchison family and friends and will keep them in our prayers.

Nancy Lee Western

I regret to inform the members of VBA that Nancy Lee Western has passed away at the age of 89. She was born in Augusta County Virginia on March 31, 1932. She was a member of VBA for more than 68 years. She has been a member of the OFG since 1971. In 1966 she "temporarily" took over the job of Corresponding Secretary. She held that position till 1992 for a total of 26 years. During those years she kept the VBA running like a clock and was always helping anyone she could. In 1986 she was nominated for the Medal of Merit. This is the second highest honorary award given by NFAA. In her early years she shot archery tournaments, hunted and fished. After retirement Nancy and Clinton traveled to all 50 states and several other countries. She made many friends in the archery world and will be missed by all.

I am writing to extend congratulations on behalf of the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources (DWR) as you celebrate the 80th anniversary of the founding of the Virginia Bowhunters Association (VBA).

The DWR has a long history of successful relationships with a variety of organizations. In fact, it is not a stretch to say that our interaction with groups composed of private citizens is a bedrock of our success. Our mission to conserve wildlife and wildlife habitat for all generations, connect people with Virginia's outdoors, and protect people and property by promoting safe outdoor experiences is buttressed by the cooperative assistance we gratefully receive from an impressive array of organizations focused on Virginia wildlife resources and wildlife-related recreation activities.

The Department's relationship with your organization, the VBA, is certainly one that we value highly. Your focus on bowhunting and the advancement and preservation of that sport in Virginia plays a significant role in fulfilling the Department's mission. The leadership you have provided in the bowhunting community and your cooperation with the DWR have resulted in truly impressive accomplishments that have benefited both organizations and the hunting community at large. A few examples include:

- **1952 Big Levels (Augusta County) Bowhunting** – A 5-day season was opened on the Big Levels refuge, which had previously been closed to all deer hunting.
- **1954 Bear and Deer Archery Seasons Established** – Prior to 1954 archery hunting for bear and deer was only allowed during the general firearms season
- **1981 Wild Turkey Archery Season Established** – Prior to 1981 archery hunting for wild turkeys was only allowed during the general firearms season
- **1985 Special Archery License Established** – This license allowed bowhunters to harvest two additional deer

- **1993 Statewide Deer Archery Season Extended** – An additional week was added to the beginning of the existing statewide deer archery season, moving the start date of the season to its current starting date on the first Saturday in October.
- **2002 Urban Archery Season Established** – This new season offered cities and towns the opportunity to expand archery season by ~4 months.
- **2010 – present** – The VBA supported the DWR plan to reintroduce elk to Virginia; sponsored state-wide charity shoots to benefit St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and Hunters for the Hungry; helped revitalize the International Bowhunter Education Program in Virginia; supported a variety of DWR initiatives such as Sunday hunting on private land, combining archery and crossbow licenses, and improvements to the urban hunting program.

This partial list of successful interactions with the DWR is laudable and a record of which you can be justifiably proud. I had the pleasure to attend your 80th anniversary banquet and based on the discussions at the event I am sure our continued partnership will result in significant accomplishments in the future.

Congratulations again on a successful 80 years and best wishes for continued leadership among the bowhunters in Virginia.

Wally and Winnie Say try this Recipe from The NRA American Hunter

Wild-game meatballs are easy to make. However, there is usually a debate on the need to add pork. This recipe uses breadcrumbs, milk and egg to add and maintain moisture in the meatballs, and it works. These 100 percent wild-game meatballs are full of flavor without foregoing the health benefits of eating wild. Part of the moisture maintenance is baking the meatballs rather than frying them.

The Mongolian sauce is an excellent addition, although the meatballs could be eaten on their own. Sauced and garnished with toasted sesame seeds allows you to serve the meatballs as an hors d'oeuvre or as a meal with rice.

Venison Meatball Ingredients

- 1½ lbs. ground venison
- ⅔ cup breadcrumbs
- ⅔ cup milk
- 1 tsp onion powder
- 1 large egg
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 tsp seasoned salt (Bearded Butcher Original)
- 1 tsp black pepper

Mongolian Sauce Ingredients

- ½ cup water
- ⅓ cup brown sugar
- ¼ cup soy sauce
- 4 cloves garlic, pressed
- 1 Tbsp fresh ginger, grated
- 1 Tbsp Sracha sauce
- 2 tsp sesame oil
- ¼ cup oyster sauce
- ¼ tsp red pepper flakes
- ¼ tsp black pepper
- 2 tsp sesame seeds, toasted

Directions

1. Place the oven rack in the center of the oven and pre-heat to 400 degrees Fahrenheit. For easy clean-up, line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. In a large bowl, combine the meatball ingredients until uniform. Do not overwork the meat.
3. Form a heaping tablespoon of the meatball mixture into 1-inch balls. Place the meatballs on the baking sheet and bake in hot oven for 10 minutes or until brown and cooked through.
4. While the meatballs are baking, combine all the Mongolian sauce ingredients in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat. Whisk the ingredients to blend and bring to a simmer for 6-8 minutes, or until the sauce thickens. Stir frequently.
5. At the same time, heat a frying pan over medium heat and sprinkle in the sesame seeds. Stir until toasted and brown.
6. Remove the cooked meatballs from the oven and place them in a serving bowl. Pour the sauce over the meatballs. Garnish with the toasted sesame seeds.

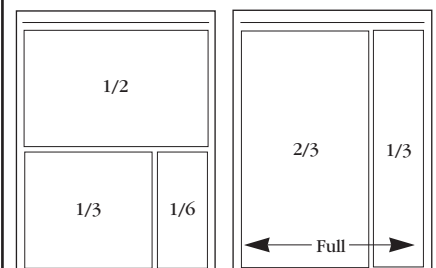

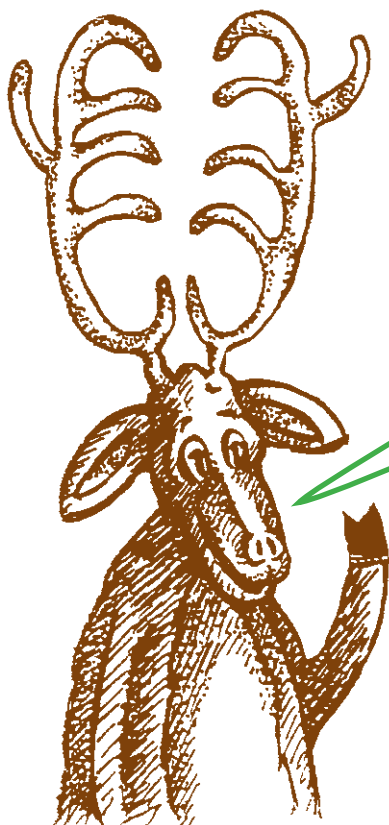

NOMINATIONS DUE IN MARCH

The VBA Order of the Golden Feather was created to honor those persons who have given unselfishly of their time and talents toward the betterment of archery and archers. Recipients are persons who possess the virtues of sportsmanship, character, morals, integrity and friendship. As a reflection of the substance for membership, only 86 people have been elected to the Order in the past 78 years.

To be qualified, a candidate must be member in good standing of the VBA at the time of nomination, must have a minimum of ten successive years' membership in the VBA and must be sponsored by three VBA members of good standing or by a VBA Club.

This article is a reminder that candidates must be submitted to the Board of Directors at the March meeting for this year. Nominations must be in writing and be signed by sponsoring individuals or a Club officer. Successful nominees have always performed duties or had an impact outside their immediate club.
